At ICON we understand that all projects are not the same, that's why we provide a variation of frame finishes to meet your specific needs. Choose from ICON's Premier Choice, Prime Painted, or Hot Dip Galvanized finishes to meet your specific needs.



Other options include Prime Painted:

- Steel is cleaned removing loose mill scale, rust, paint, and other detrimental foreign matter.
- The cleaned steel will then be prime painted with quick dry, lead and chromate free alkyd primed.
- Finish painting is completed in the field by installers.

Or Hot Dipped Galvanized:

- Steel is cleaned removing loose mill scale, rust, paint, and other detrimental foreign matter.
- The cleaned steel is then immersed in a bath of molten zinc metal.
- The resulting galvanized steel requires no maintenance for decades.

ICON's Premier Choice includes a combination of liquid epoxy primer and two coats of TGIC polyester powder coating.

- Steel is shot-blasted to meet SSPC-SP10 specification (nearly white condition), removing all oil residue, mill scale, weld spatter, and slag.
- The steel is then immersed in zinc phosphate completing an 8-stage pre-treatment process.
- Next, liquid epoxy is electrostatically applied and coated to a uniform 0.7-0.9 mils. This **E-Coat Powdercoat** provides total encapsulation which prevents rusting.
- Lastly, a double coat of TGIC polyester powder is applied. One coat of color followed by one clear coating for a final finish that is 8-12 mils thick.



ICON worked with a design task force to develop swirling arcs of lime green to create a colorful overhead canopy, featuring uplighting to enhance the appearance after dark. The result is a perfect space where library patrons can gather, take a break, end enjoy the outdoors.

For many decades, Pearl Street Park has stood in the Brooklyn neighborhood of Charlotte. It originated, complete with gardens and sports fields, to provide park land to the African American population living in and around the area. Land for the park was purchased by the city from the Thompson Orphanage in 1943, and over the years has been the site of Victory Gardens, football practice for Second Ward High School, and many family gatherings. Today, it has been completely renovated while honoring its history and landscape. ICON worked in collaboration to design both a restroom and a multi-purpose pavilion which often hosts performances and community events, so the park can continue to serve families for many years to come.





ICON LIMITED WARRANTY

ICON Shelter Systems, Inc. warrants to the original purchaser of its products that it will provide materials free from manufacturing defects, that will be structurally sound, and can be assembled with normal expertise and tools required and practiced in the construction industry. The limited warranty is for a period of ten (10) years from the date of invoice with the following terms and conditions:

This warranty is in effect only if the structure has been assembled and installed strictly in accordance with ICON installation drawings and good construction practices and has been subjected only to normal use and exposure.

This warranty is valid only if the structures are maintained according to proper maintenance procedures; have been subjected to only normal use for the purpose for which the goods were designed; have not been subjected to addition or substitution of parts; and have not been modified, altered, or repaired without the approval of an Icon Shelter Systems' approved representative in any respect which, in the judgment of Icon Shelter Systems, affects the condition or operation of the structures.

The owner shall notify ICON to arrange for an inspection within thirty (30) days after discovery of any defect under this warranty, and before any alteration or repair is made or attempted.

ICON is in no way responsible for damages caused by others, including vandalism,

fire, lightning, or acts of God, corrosion caused by moisture, chemicals, air or salt spray, pollution, or infestation by rodents or other vermin.






Interior view of Vented roof option


Primary Roof Decks for Steel Frame Structures

24 GAUGE STEEL PANELS

The 24 ga. galvalume roof panels have a Kynar 500 paint finish. Multi-Rib and Mega-Rig are 36" wide panels that are pre-cut in our factory to fit your shelter. Medallion-Lok standing seam is provided uncut, to be cut to fit in the field by others.

All steel roof panels have a standard, white-washed color on the underside of the panel. This will be visible without a sub roof deck.

2X6 TONGUE AND GROOVE

The 2x6 tongue and groove (T&G) wood roof is kiln dried Western Lodgepole Pine. T&G requires finished roofing materials.
